Marie Curie was born in Warsaw (Poland) on November 7, 1867 and died in Passy (France)


Wangari Maathai

She was a Kenyan social, environmental, and political activist and the first African woman to win the Nobel Prize. She was best known with her Green Belt Movement in Kenya.




Sabiha Gökçen
